St Croix County Fair

The St Croix County Fair will be held from 20-24 July this year. Associated with the Fair is the group Friends of the St Croix County Fairplex, founded in 2008. President Chris Libby told us about the “Renovations for Generations” campaign that is underway. The goal is to improve or build four separate buildings. In 2010, work on the 4-H Food Stand was completed. This year, a new Dairy Barn was constructed, the first new animal building on the site for many decades. Significant help was provided by the Hudson Home Depot store, both in terms of materials and volunteer hours. The Dairy Barn will be dedicated the day the Fair opens.

The Friends group holds two signature fundraisers – a May Fair, and a Raffle that is underway now. Over \$80,000 was raised last year, and the group has brought in over \$50,000 this year.

Over 1000 youth and adults are active in 4-H in St Croix Country. The Fair is the big event for group members, as told by Nancy Burman. She told our group how 4-H brought each of her children interesting experiences and life skills.

Two 4-H youth ambassadors also spoke to the group about how 4-H has helped them grow. Heidi Feyereisen will be a senior at St Croix Central high school this fall, and is active in the Roberts Ribbon Reapers club. Logan Hammer will be a sophomore at Hudson high school this fall, and participates through the Rolling Hills club.
